Junior Camps

A fun, engaging introduction to the game of golf.

Junior Camps are designed to help young players build a strong foundation in a positive and energetic environment. Our overall goal is to teach the game of golf through fun instruction, friendly competition, games, and prizes. Each camp runs for two mornings and is led by our experienced PGA Professionals, Zayne Slotten (Head Golf Professional) and Tyler Dixon (Assistant Golf Professional).

Program Details

- **Ages:** 5 – 14 years old
- **Duration:** 2 Days (8:00 AM – 10:00 AM each morning)
- **Group Size:** Max 40 per camp (first 40 paid entries)
- **Best For:** Beginners & young golfers new to the game

Curriculum

- **Day 1:** Short game fundamentals, including pitching and chipping. We also cover essential golf etiquette to ensure players understand how to behave on the course.
- **Day 2:** Full swing mechanics, putting techniques, and the basic rules of golf.

Throughout both days, players will participate in hands-on coaching, fun competitions, and have the opportunity to win prizes.

Operation 36

The most effective and fun way to learn how to play golf.

Operation 36 is the cornerstone of The Muni School of Golf's junior development pathway. This nationally recognized program combines expert coaching sessions with real on-course play to help golfers improve step by step. The genius of Operation 36 is that it scales the golf course down to a beginner's skill level, allowing players to experience immediate success and build confidence from their very first round.

How It Works — 4 Simple Steps

- **Step 1 — Play from Level 1:** Players begin just 25 yards from the hole (Level 1). Every hole is a Par 4, so the goal is to shoot 36 for 9 holes. This is achievable from Day 1!
- **Step 2 — Shoot 36 to Level Up:** Once a player shoots 36 or better, they advance to the next level. The course progressively gets longer: 25 → 50 → 100 → 150 → 200 yards → Red Tees → White Tees → Blue Tees.
- **Step 3 — Learn the 12 Core Skills:** Our coaches teach 12 core skills per level in weekly group classes.
- **Step 4 — Train & Track with the App:** The Operation 36 App gives players and parents all the tools to track progress, watch 72 educational skill videos, and know exactly how to practice outside of class.

The Curriculum: 12 Core Skills

Players progress through 6 levels, mastering 12 core skills at each stage. The curriculum covers:

He has competed in the prestigious PGA Professional Championship four times and has playing experience on the PGA Tour Latinoamérica. After successfully running the Travis Hofland Golf Academy in the Treasure Valley, where he developed some of the top junior players in Idaho, he has returned home to Twin Falls. His passion is helping golfers of all ages reach their full potential, with a special focus on developing the next generation of elite junior players.

Zayne Slotten, PGA

Head Golf Professional

Zayne Slotten is the Head Golf Professional at Twin Falls Golf Club and a fierce competitor within the Rocky Mountain Section. He recently captured the 2024 National Car Rental Rocky Mountain Section PGA Assistant Professional Championship in a dramatic playoff, earning a spot in the National Championship in Florida. He is also the Snake River Chapter Match Play Champion, having won an epic 21-hole final. His competitive success also includes a victory at the Facility Championship alongside his colleagues, and he has also competed in the PGA Professional Championship. Zayne brings his high-level playing experience directly to his teaching, helping junior golfers understand not just swing mechanics, but course management, scoring strategy, and how to handle pressure.

A Legacy of Championship Golf at the Twin Falls Golf Club

Since 2006, Twin Falls High School has built one of the most dominant golf programs in the state of Idaho, capturing 12 combined IHSAA 5A State Championships (5 Boys titles and 7 Girls titles, including the 2025 Girls State Championship).
